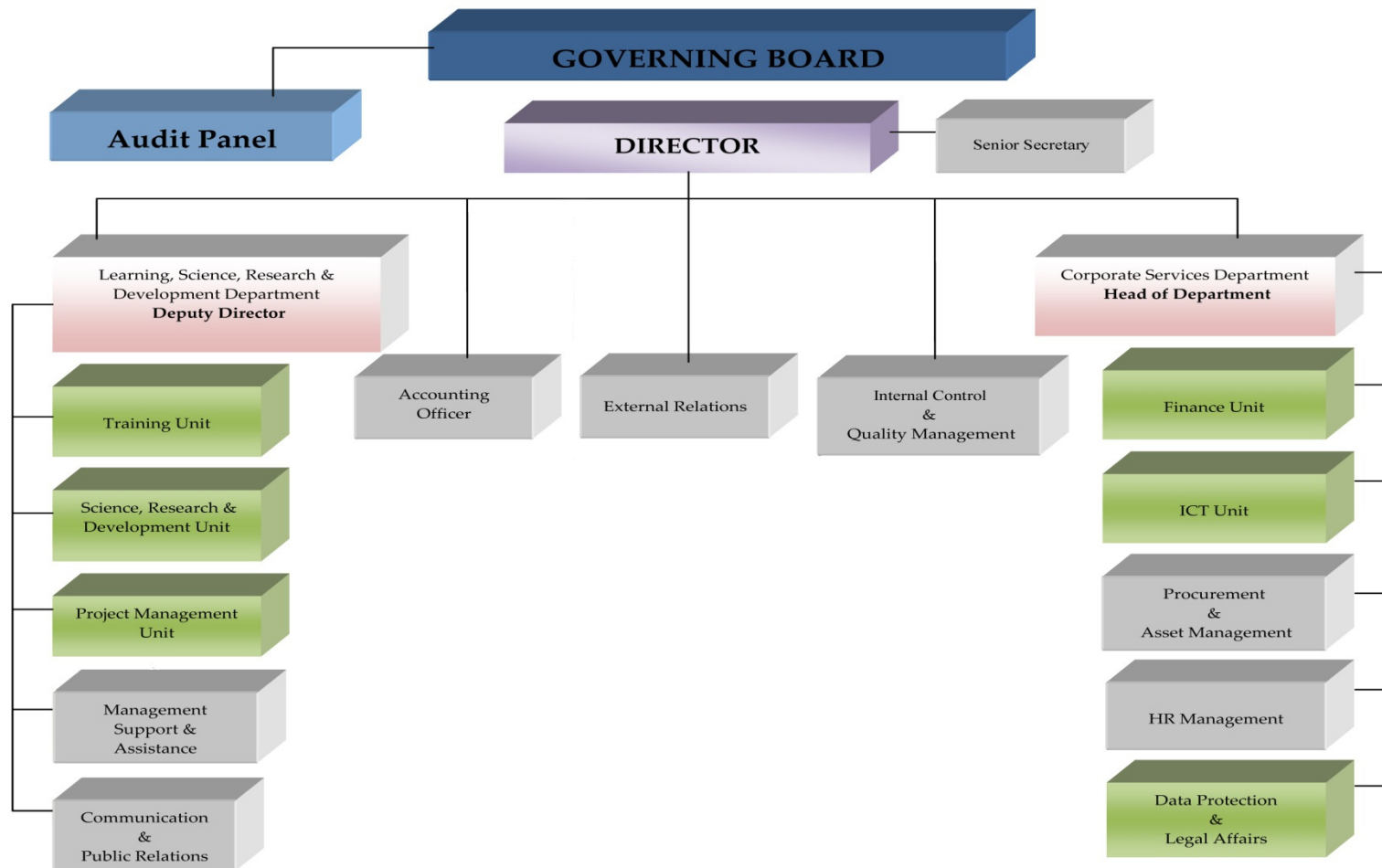
Collège Européen de Police - European Police College

CEPOL European Police Exchange Programme - Framework

- EC / CEPOL covers
 - ✓ Cost for flight
 - ✓ Cost for hotel (half board basis)
 - ✓ eventually lunch and domestic transport has to be covered by sending country
- Exchange period
 - ✓ 13 days / 12 nights
 - ✓ if both parties agree the period could be shortened to five working days
- Mutual Exchange
 - ✓ host – Exchangee and Exchangee - host

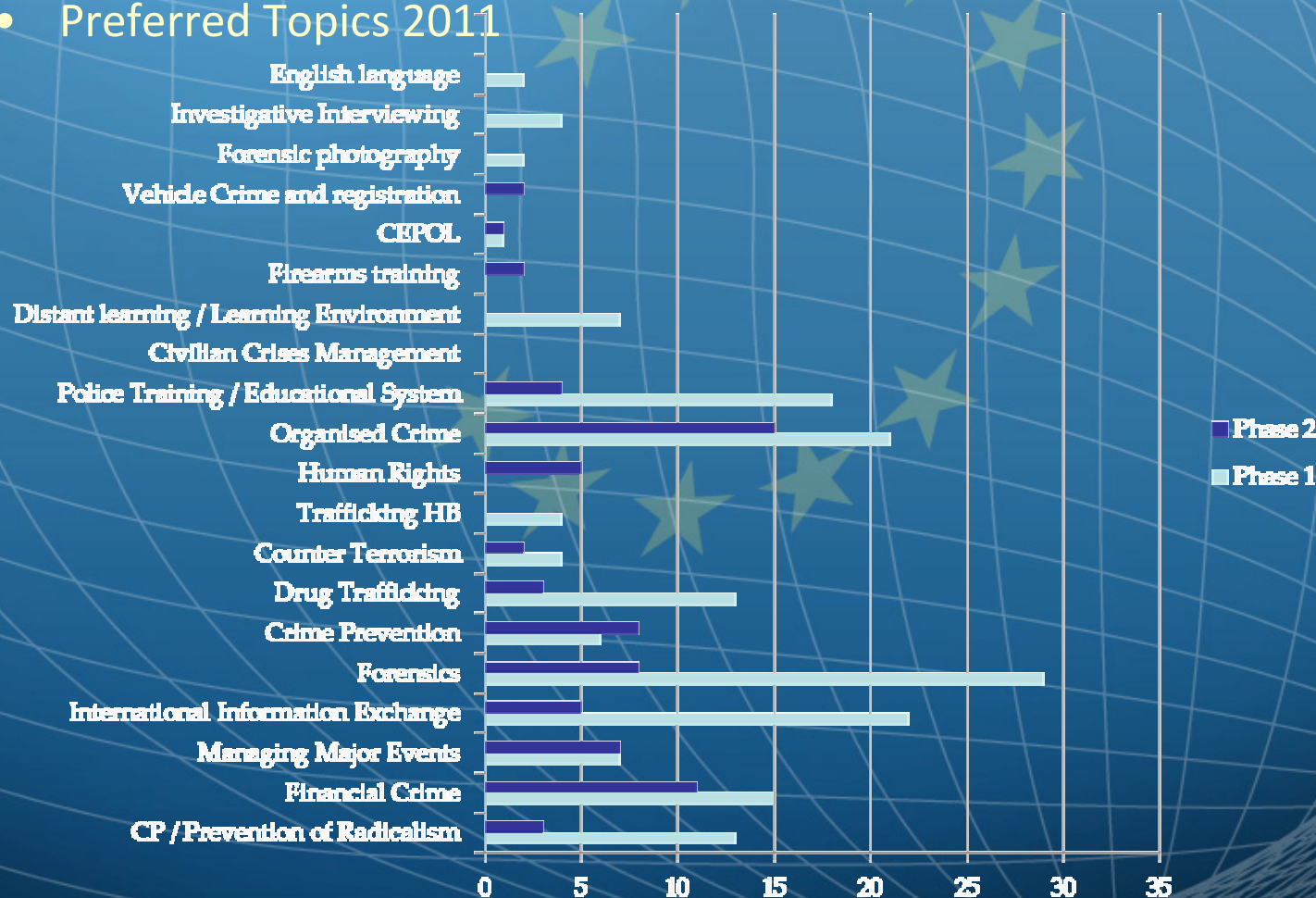

CEPOL European Police Exchange Programme – Commanders 2011

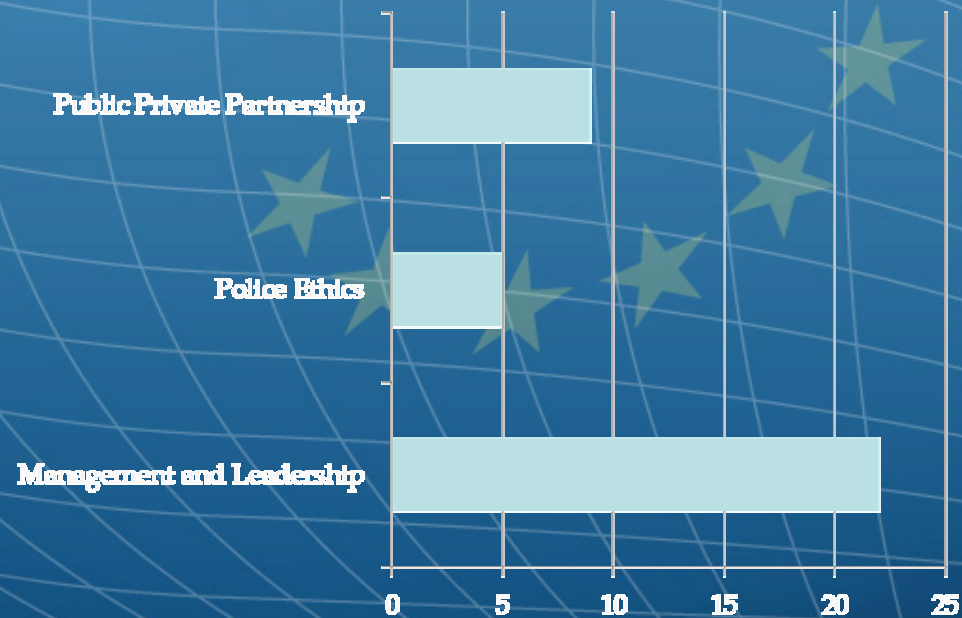

- 2nd Europol study visit

 - 11 – 13 July 2012 in Lisbon
- Frontex
 - In October 2012 in Warsaw
- OLAF
 - 11 – 13 June 2012 in Brussels
